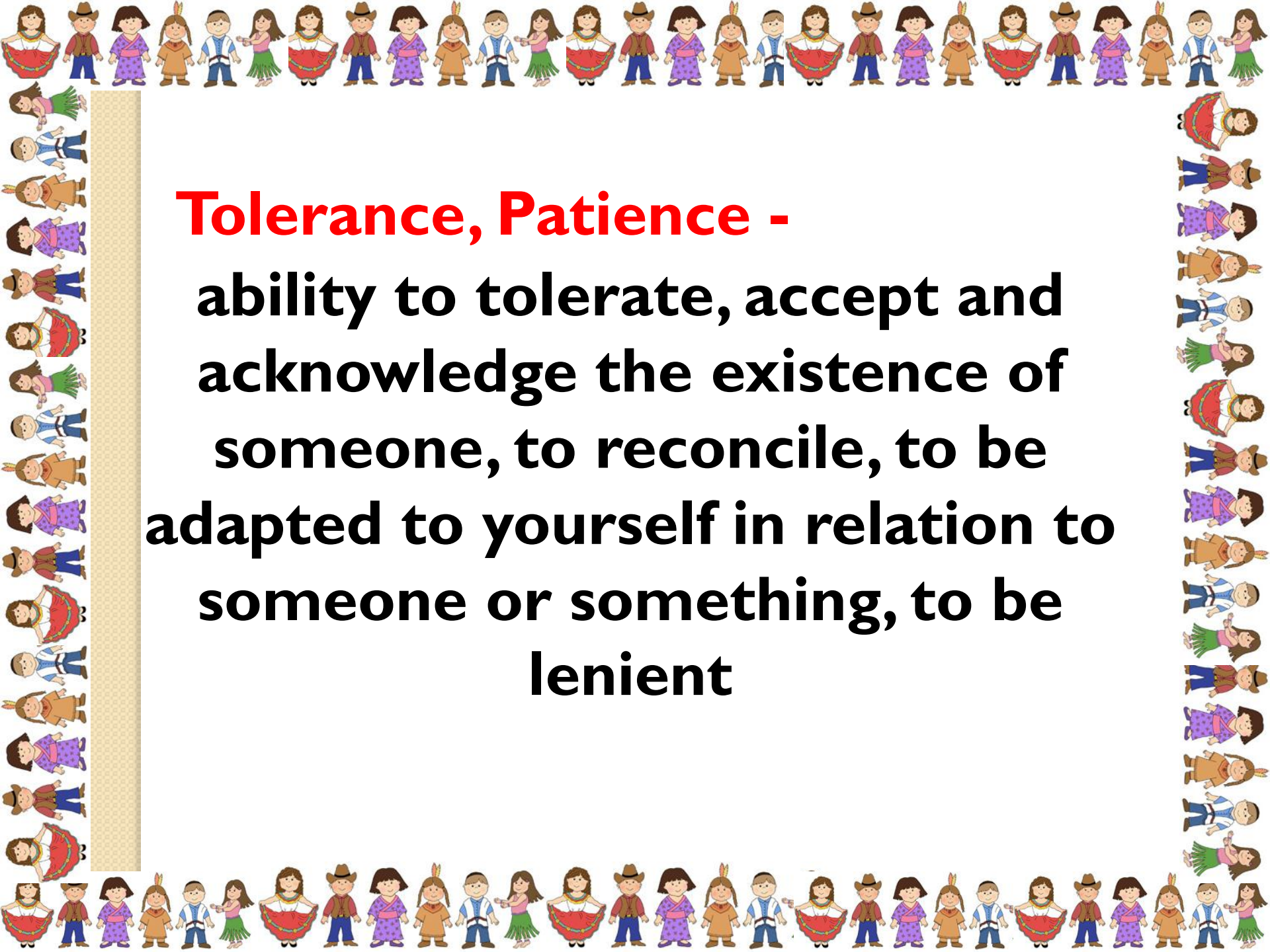

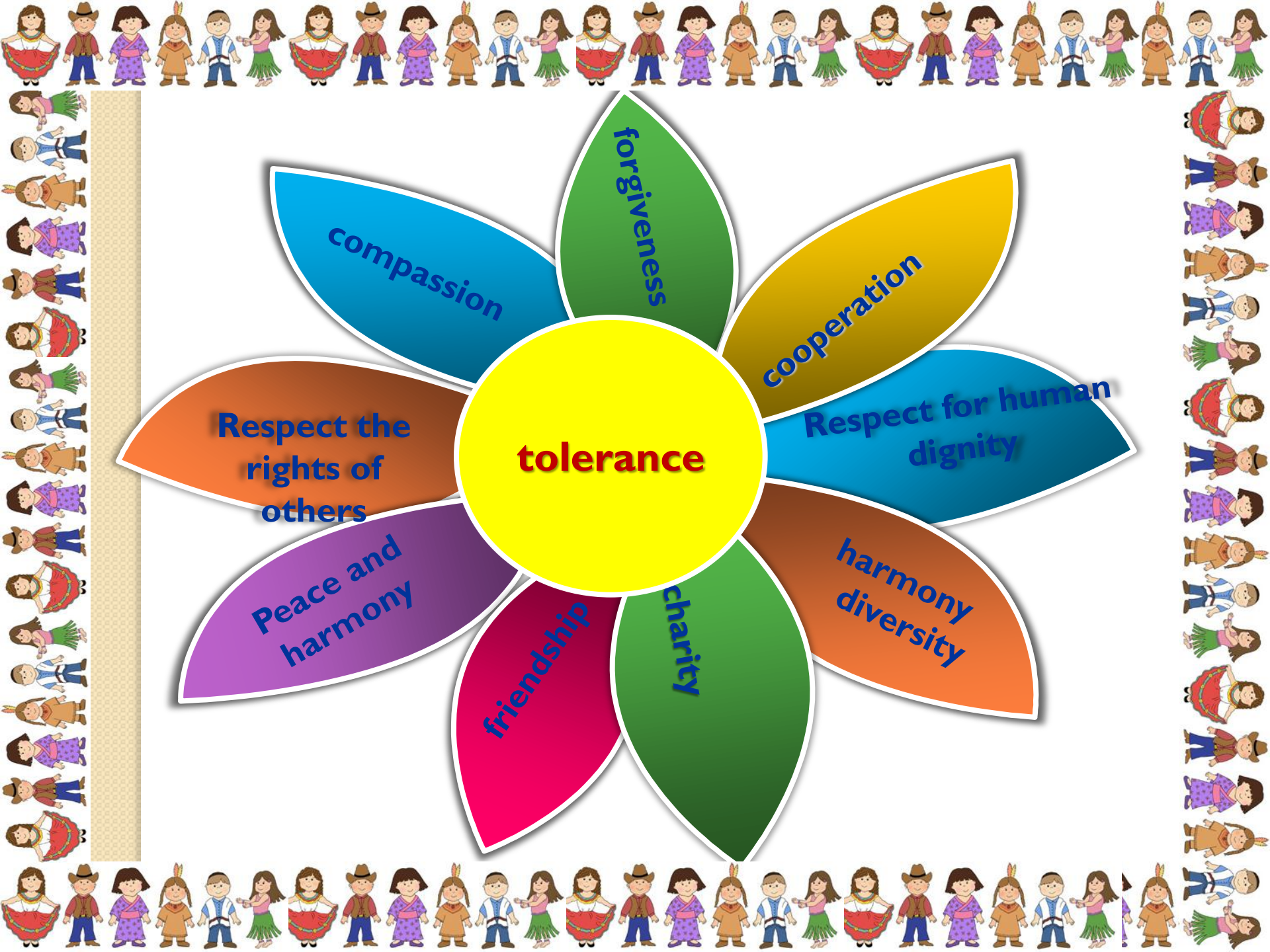
Basics of Tolerance

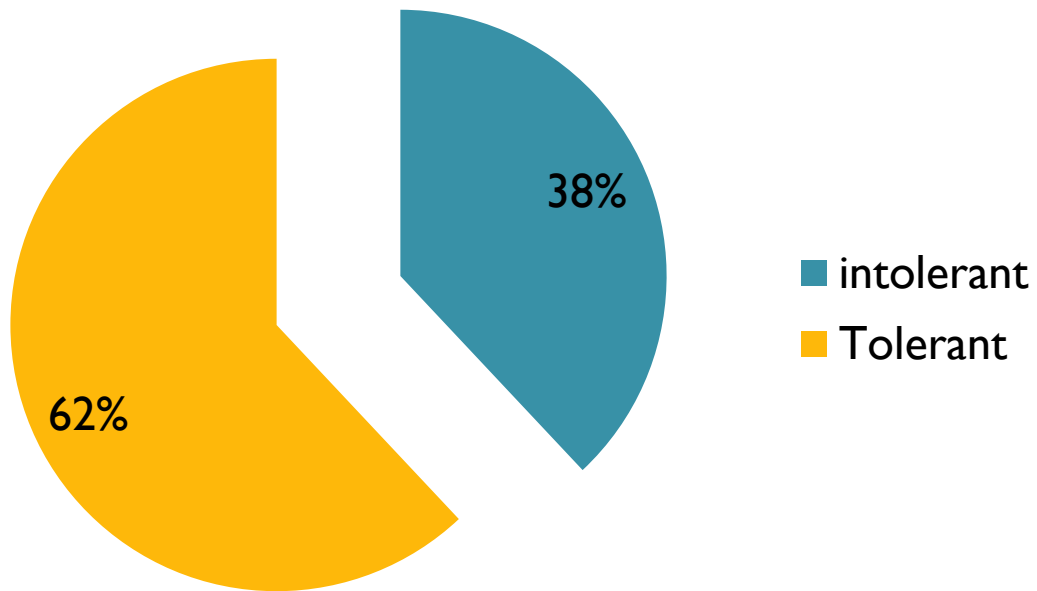

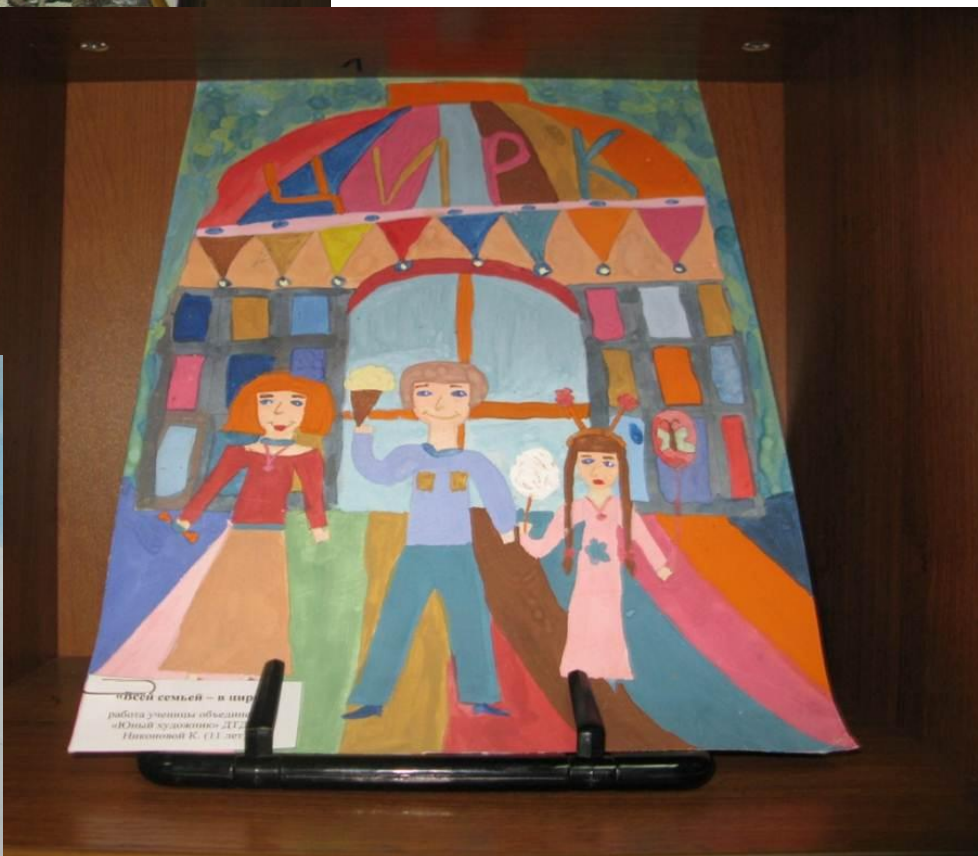

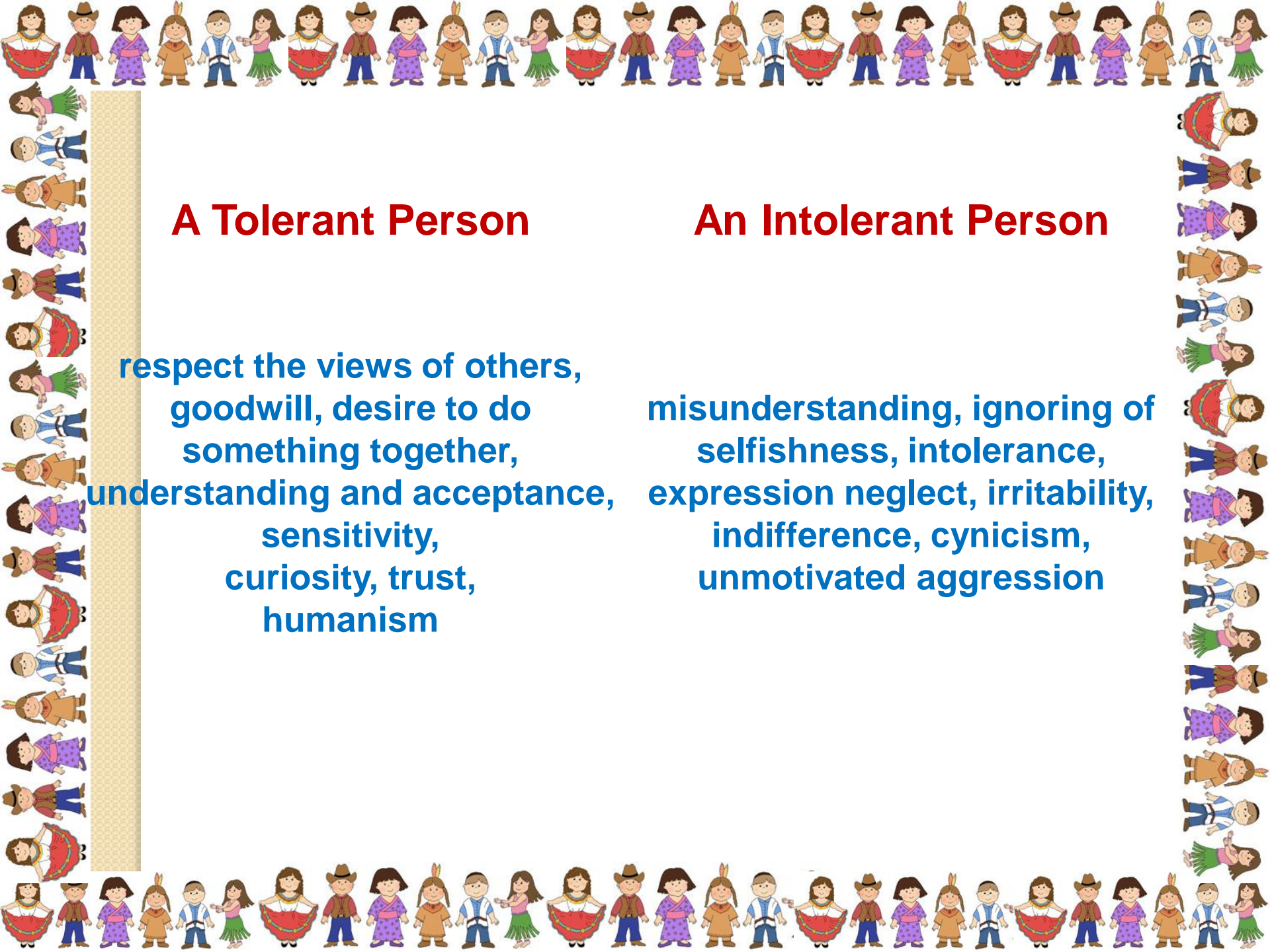

A Tolerant Person

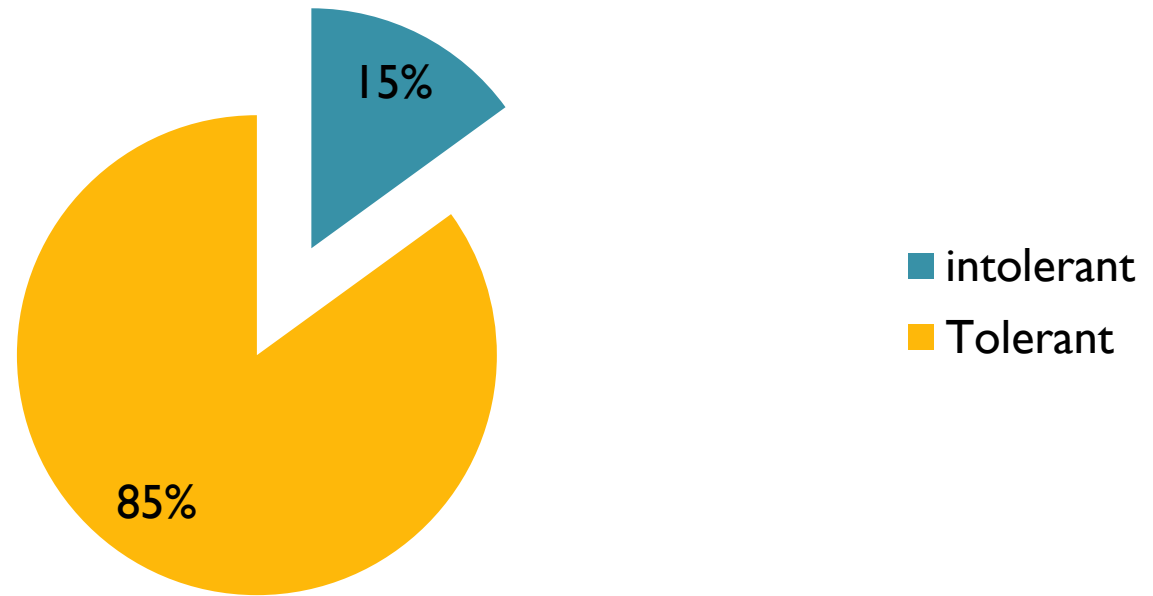
